

Summer 2020 Rules and Procedures for the Thompson Spray Park
July 1st – August 28th
11 am – 6 pm

1. Temporary fencing will be installed around the spray park to allow for a single point of entry and exit.
2. A Recreation Department Park Supervisor will allow (25) users at a time into the park. When in the spray area, park users should maintain a 6' distance from other park users at all times.
3. The waiting area for park users will be marked out in 6' intervals for safe social distancing.
4. Each group of (25) users will be given 15-minutes to cool off and use the park. At the end of 15-minutes, the Park Supervisor will blow a whistle to clear the facility. At that time, the next group of (25) users will be allowed in the spray area. There is no limit to how many times a park user can get back in line to use the park.
5. Park Monitors will be in the spray area to encourage social distancing and push the activation buttons to initiate the water jets. ONLY the Park Monitors will touch the spray park activation controls.
6. We ask that all spray park spectators place their blankets, chairs, and other belongings outside of the fenced area and at a minimum of 12' away from other spectators. All parents, guardians, and other adults supervising should monitor children at all times for proper distancing and proper face covering.
7. The facility will be a trash carry in and carry out facility. NO trash cans will be available on site.
8. Please note that NO public restroom will be available on site.
9. Staff will clean all high touch points at the end of each day.
10. After visiting the spray park, users should wash their hands or use hand sanitizer.
11. All park visitors should self-screen prior to arriving. This includes checking their temperature (temperature of 100.0°F or above is considered a fever), and for symptoms including fever, cough, shortness of breath, gastrointestinal symptoms, abdominal pain, unexplained rash, new loss of taste/smell, muscle aches, or any other symptoms that feel like a cold. Anyone with a fever of 100.0°F or above and/or any other signs of illness or recovering from an illness will **NOT** be permitted to enter the park.
12. No large groups or camps are allowed.
13. No toys, cups, or equipment of any kind allowed in the spray area.
14. The spray park will be closed in the event of inclement weather.
